

Massachusetts Haitian Community Action Plan

To contribute to Social-Economic Development of Haiti and the Massachusetts Haitian Community:

1- Teaching of Patriotism/Civism in the Boston Haitian Community, the Diaspora and Haiti.

To work with H.A.U. who has been successfully promoted Haitian Patriotism in the Boston Haitian Community for the past five years through:

- A- Patriotic events such as Independence Day Gala, Flag Raising Ceremony, Unity Parade, and Haitian Heritage Month Celebration.
- B- Interviews on radio and television programs, two live call-in television programs on Tele Kreyol, two spots for Radio and one for television.
- C- The Toussaint Louverture's Scholarship Fund for Haitian-American students.
- D- H.A.U. gallery in Mattapan, which will be transformed into a museum and a library when H.A.U. opens its Haitian Cultural Center of Boston, Massachusetts.
- E- The new TV program "The Haitian Patriot" aired in Boston on Channel 23 Saturday 8-9 AM and Friday 10-11 AM
The "Haitian Patriot" program will also be aired on radio and the internet, and a newsletter or newspaper will be created using the same name.

To add civic education to the H.A.U.'s project, and encourage the teaching in other communities in the Diaspora, and extend it in Haiti.

2- Uniting and organizing the Haitian Community of Massachusetts.

- A- Encouraging the foundation of more Haitian organizations such as:
Association of Haitian Professionals,

Association of Haitian Cab Drivers,

Haitian Chamber of Commerce
- B- Working at resurrecting the association of Haitian Parents, the Association of Haitian Teachers, the Association of Haitian Doctors, and so one.
- C- Getting the old and new organizations to join our group in forming Alliance of Haitian-American organizations and Concerned Citizens (AHAOCC)
- D- Promoting respect and dialog between everyone.
- E- Encouraging Haitian-Americans to vote and run for elected positions.

3- Providing Humanitarian Aid to Haiti.

- A- Finding medical supplies to send to hospitals and Health centers
- B- Getting ambulances, beds for hospitals
- C- Creating a voluntary corps for Haitian Physicians and nurses to go help in Haiti's hospitals and Health centers, and for other professionals and students to go help in some other capacities.
- D- Developing H.A.U. community intervention bank account into a good permanent emergency relief fund

4- Encouraging Haitian investments and supporting development projects.

- A- Creation of a credit union or an association of investors
- B- Work with the regional organizations on different projects.
